

FROM THE VOLUNTEERS.—The prisoners now in the hands of the volunteers, 130 in number, are now on their way to this place, and will be quartered near here until they can be removed to some reservation, from whence they will not find their way back. With a view to this Gen. Kibbe started below yesterday, and will return again next week to superintend their removal. In the meantime the troops under Capt. Messic, will prosecute the war.

P. S. Since the above was in type we learn that the prisoners have arrived in Union, and will probably be quartered there till Gen. Kibbe returns.
