

TROOPS FOR THE MOUNTAINS.—On the 15th ult., we announced that Capt. Lovell, commanding Fort Humboldt, had ordered Lieut. Lynn with a detachment of 30 men to Yager Creek and South Fork Eel river. We learned subsequently that the command did not proceed far, owing to high water in the streams. On yesterday Lieut. Lynn left with the detachment, under the same orders published, but proceeds direct to South Fork. Application has been made by citizens living on Yager Creek, for a small detachment, to be stationed temporarily in that neighborhood to guard against depredations from the Indians. The presence of a few troops in that country would be salutary, and we have no doubt Capt. Lovell will comply with the request if practicable.
