~~Resolved, That we, the undersigned, believing that the sale, gift, repairing or loan of fire arms or ammunition of any description to Indians, is pregnant with danger to the white inhabitants of this place; do hereby pledge ourselves to do all in our power to stop said traffic, repairing or loaning of arms and ammunition.~~

~~Resolved, That all persons detected in said traffic, will be punished as follows:~~

~~To have their heads shaved; to receive twenty-five lashes, and afterwards be driven from the river.~~

~~Resolved, Further, that any person violating the State law, and who shall have sufficient property to cover all costs of carrying the law into execution, in this regard said property will be taken by us in the absence of the properly constituted authorities of the land, and sold in execution.~~
