By reference to the letter of our special corres ent at the Capital, it will be seen that there is addition al intelligence of Indian disturbances. An express was received on Sunday evening from Mailposa county, an nouncing the fact that a battle had been lought be tween the whites and Indians of Mariposa county The Indians were entrenched at one of their villages, but were driven off with a loss of about sixty killed and from ten to wenty wounded. It also appears that seventy-two Americans were surprised and murdered by the Indians, near Rattlesnake creekad Prompt and efficient measures will be neces sary to quiet the Indians, and we doubt if in the present stage of affairs; it will be possible to treat with them, without recourse to arms. Our Indian commissioners must bestir themselves if they expect to be of service to the people of California.
