A concurrent resolution was passed, requi-
ring the Secretary of State to make a correct
copy of all the muster rolls of the volun-
teers who had served in the Indian Wars,
and that the Governor be requested to for-
ward the same to the Adjutant General of the
United States at Washington. The object of
this resolution is that all said volunteers can
obtain their Bounty Lands, as awarded them
by Act of Congress in 1855. A lengthy
discussion then ensued upon some parlia-
mentary motions, which were entirely devoid
of public interest, when the Senate adjourned.
The Assembly have made the bill to appoint
a Commissioner to visit Washington City,
for the purpose of getting the Indian War
debt audited, the special order for Thursday
next. A committee of three was appointed
to elect a State translator. Nothing further
of interest has transpired. Jrs.
