

FROM FORT GASTON.—We have a letter from one of the Trinity Company, dated Jan. 4th, from which we gain the following information: On the 21st December Lieut. Col. Whipple and Staff arrived at that post, and Fort Gaston was announced as Headquarters of the Humboldt Military District. The same day Co. K, 2nd Infantry, C. V., arrived at the Fort. Col. Whipple on the day following assumed command of the Post, and Adjutant Hanna relieved Lieut. John A. Watson of the duties of Post Adjutant. The latter still fills the position of Quartermaster there. Nelson Leonard, of Canon City, who was wounded in the fight of December 22d, at Bald Mountain, has nearly recovered, and will soon be able to do duty.
