

MAN KILLED.—The Yreka *Union* says that Mr. Angel, of Yreka, had been killed by the Indians, about a mile from Jacksonville. It appears that a party of volunteers and about thirty regulars left on Wednesday last, for a point on Applegate, where a body of Indians were supposed to be congregated. Mr. Angel and Mr. Waggoner, starting a little ahead, were about a quarter of a mile in advance of the soldiers, when a company of Indians fired upon them, killing Angel instantly. The further particulars we have not learned. Waggoner said that he saw no more than about eight Indians in the party.—*Alta*.
