

MOVEMENTS OF THE VOLUNTEERS.—The storm the latter part of last week, and the early part of this, was so severe in the mountains that it was impossible for the men to travel much. On Tuesday of last week, Capt. Messie joined Lieut. Winslett at Elk Prairie, where the whole command encamped until the forepart of this week, when we learned they moved over on Mad River, where they prepared themselves for another start, and we are now in daily expectation of hearing of another engagement.

— On Friday, the 28th ult, Lieut. Winslett came upon a band of Indians on Redwood, when a skirmish ensued, in which Frank McCafferty was wounded in the hip, and several Indians killed. A large quantity of their provisions was destroyed, and it is now thought that they cannot hold out in a body much longer.
