

**INDIAN DIFFICULTIES IN PITT RIVER VALLEY.**—From Capt. Judah, of Fort Jones, Scott Valley, who arrived in town on Wednesday evening last, says the Shasta Courier, we learn that there has been another outbreak among the Pitt River Indian. Captain Judah informs us that information had come to him that all the houses in the Valley had been burnt, and it is supposed that all the inhabitants beyond the possibility of a doubt, have been murdered. Frank Rogers, formerly of the firm of Gram, Rogers & Co., with a small party, had left Yreka on snow shoes, for the purpose of finding the body of his father, Mr. Z. R. Rogers.
