teers this week. Gen Kibbe left Union on  
Sunday last for Hoopa Valley to bring out  
some Hoopa Indians with whom he had made  
~~arrangements to bring in the Redwood Indi-~~  
ans. Capt Underwood, Commander of the  
post there, was doing what he could to pre-  
vent the Indians from rendering Gen. Kibbe  
any assistance. We are not at all surprised  
at this, and it only corroborates an assertion  
we made some time since, for which we were  
taken to task by our neighbor of the *Cal-*  
*ifornia*. We expect to hear interesting news  
from that quarter soon.
