

INDIANS AGAIN.—The Indians have again begun depredations and outrages in the region of Chico. They attacked a settler's cabin near Chico, and drove him off, after firing at him several times without effect, and robbed the house of everything valuable it contained, including \$500 in money. One George Hays, while attending sheep near Pence's Ranch, was shot twice, but escaped with his life, and will recover from his wounds. The Indians had firearms. Major Bidwell has gone out with a company in chase of them.
