The ANTELOUE INDIANS.—Dr. Inskeep informs us that he can call to mind fourteen men-who have been shot at by Indians, in his meighborhood, within a few months, besides those who have been murdered. Ninesguns and three pistols have been stolen within the same-time, besides munition, and a large amount of other property. The people of the neighborhood are said to be in constant-fear.
