The Indians on several of the Reservations in this State have been taught a considerable degree of industry: On the Klamath Reservation this season, almost totally unassisted by white labor, the Indians have raised 1,250,000 lbs. potatoes; 30,000 lbs. peas; 13,000 lbs. pate: 6,000 lbs. beans; 16,000 lbs. turnips; 5,000 bushels pumpkins; 6,000 lbs. wheat.
