

THE VOLUNTEERS.--Mr. John Ludwig, returned from the Humboldt war, states that Calvin Gunn, who was so badly wounded, has entirely recovered, and has gone with the Indian escort to Mendocino Reservation. Forty-five of the men were camped on Redwood Creek, fifteen miles the other side of Hoopa Valley. If they conclude to return without baggage, they will be here in a day or two. Two days were occupied in attempting to break the road, but two miles only were accomplished in that time.
