~~Energetic measures should be taken by those in command to dispel this dark cloud from the Northern horizon as speedily as possible. Our countrymen in that section have a right to be protected in life and property, and it is a lasting shame on those whose business it is to put an end to this Indian war, to suffer things to drag along as at present.~~
