

INDIAN SUPERINTENDENT FOR CALIFORNIA.—A Special dispatch to the New York Herald, dated at Washington March 10th says:

James Y. McDuffie has been confirmed as Superintendent of Indian Affairs in California. Commissioner Denver again protested against McDuffie's appointment to any position under the Indian Bureau, and informed the President that he should resign if the appointment was made. Nugent, of California, however, insisted on the appointment being made over Denver's protest. He has carried the day, and tomorrow Denver will resign his office as Commissioner of Indian Affairs.
