Hodda Reservation.—Congress has appropriated \$60,000 for the purchase of the improvements in Hooda Valley. It this is in Trensury Notes, as we presume is the case, this is about half their appraised value. A few days, previous, to its final passage, it was defeated in the House, being opposed by Cornelius Cole. Afterwards, in the last hours of the session, it was tacked on to the general appropriation bill, and so received the sanction of both houses. We shall take occasion to refer to this matter again.
