

BURIAL OF THE VICTIMS.—The burial of Mr. Shannon, killed in the fight with the Indians on Sunday last, took place on Monday, at the Ranch of Mr. Jacob Henderson near the Neme Lackee Reservation. There was quite a large attendance of the neighbors, and to-day he received decent and Christian burial. Dr. Jeffries read the funeral service of the Episcopal Church at the grave, in a solemn and impressive manner. The deceased was a worthy and respectable citizen of Round Valley, and his death will be sorely lamented by the residents of that place, as well as by all who were acquainted with him. He was a resident of North-western Virginia, aged about 37 years.

The remains of Mr. Ford were taken by his friends to Stony creek, where he formerly resided, and where he will be interred. He was spoken of as a most excellent young man, highly respected by his neighbors.
