INDIAN TROUBLES IN TEHAMA.—The Red Bluff Independent relates the following: . A band of Indians, numbering over sixty about two weeks ago, made their appearance in the vicinity of Cow Creek, where | I they stole a horse, robbed a cabin of a gun and some money, and came down to West's ranch, about fourteen miles N. E. from here. where they stole two valuable team mules, belonging to Mr. Farrel, of this town, and worth about \$600. At first they did not suppose that it was the work of Indians, but in their search for the mules they discovered Indian tracks, and met a company from Cow Creek in search of their horse; they all joined together and followed up in the trail until they reached the rancheria on Mill Creek, about twenty miles from Red Bluff. The Indians discovered the party when about half a mile distant, and broke for the mountains; they, however, encoueded in killing two, and wounding some others. They found nearly all the mule flesh, along with part of two carcasses of beef. They captured the horse alive, after a hard run between a Cow Creek man and an Indian. The citizens living in this range of country have suffered severely from those Indians, and are determined to take the matter in their own bands. A meeting is to be held at Hazlerigg's store, on Bear Creek, on the 4th inst., to take into consideration the raising of a company. for the purpose exterminating this band, or in some way break it up, to prevent further aggression. The Indians here spoken of are quite conversant with the English lahguage, and have some good -guas-in their possession,
