

INDIAN WAR DEBT.—The Washington correspondent of the *Union* says: "The California Indian War Debt, assumed by your State and reimbursable to California under the Act of 1861, has been under examination in the Treasury Department, and only a few formalities are necessary, when the amount due the State, something over \$220,000, will be ready for the Secretary of the Treasury to turn over to the State of California. Secretary Chase intended, originally, to issue bonds for the amount, but it is now probable that he will notify the proper parties that the sum in question is in the Treasury, subject to draft. The California debt will be ready for payment in the course of a few weeks, it is thought."
