Honnin Caughty Four men, who have been hunting for some time past, in the mounmins, about twenty-five miles northcast of this, met with a serious loss last week. They were caniped on Battle Creek, about ten or twelve miles beyond Cold Spring Valley, and, in the night, the Indians made a descent upon their horses, which were picketed out some distance from their camp, and killed three fout of the four by cutting their throats and states fling them back of the shoulder. We hope. to hear of the settlers in that section taking the matter in hand, and without any fuss. or excitement, coolly wipe these bloodthinsty savages out of existence.
