

INDIAN FIGHT.—The Colusa *Sun* contains an account of an Indian fight, near Little Stony creek, between a party of whites and a band of Pitt River Indians, under the leadership of the notorious Hat Creek Lize, well known in the Pitt River country as a desperate Indian woman of large stature, and celebrated for various barbarities. Two of the whites, S. W. Shannon and S. R. Ford were killed, and about fifteen of the Indians, among whom was Lize and two other squaws. This band had been guilty of robbing houses, killing stock, and the murder Mr. H. Wasson and an Indian boy who was herding sheep.
