

'Injins'—We learn from W. I. Reed, who is in the employ of the Quarter-Master's Department of Fort Humboldt, that the train engaged in packing supplies from the Fort to Capt. Lovell's camp, was attacked by Indians on Sunday last. Several shots were fired, and one Indian, who was along with the train, wounded. The attack took place in the Bald Hills, near the same place where Mr. Ball was killed, some four years since.
