

One of the Redwood Indians captured last winter and sent to the Mendocino Reservation, returned a few days since; he reports that twenty Indians—thirteen of them squaws and children—left that Reservation for the purpose of returning to their old homes. They went to an Indian ranch in the vicinity of Long Valley for the purpose of obtaining food, when they were attacked by the Indians of that vicinity, and all killed except himself.—*Northern Californian*.
