we were going to press we received a  
letter from Sergeant J. N. Jones, of  
Capt. Qusley's company, from which we  
learn that Lieut. Hempfield came upon  
the Indians at the head of Willow Creek  
and recovered a number of animals be-  
longing to the train captured last week,  
and some belonging to other parties.  
Among the number were two belonging  
to the United States. Considerable  
clothing and other articles were taken  
but the Indians succeeded in making  
their escape by flight, after firing about  
thirty shots. No white men hurt.
