

INDIAN WAR.— We learn from the Globe, that prompt action is being taken by Gen. Clarke in regard to the Indian war. The disastrous intelligence from Col. Steptoe's command was no sooner received, than orders were at once transmitted for the centering of troops at that point, and the prompt punishment of the Indians. Two companies have been ordered from San Bernardino, one from the Klamath, one from Jones' Fort, and also the one under the command of Capt. Keyes. Eight hundred regulars will be in the field early in August.
