

~~FIGHT WITH THE INDIANS~~ From a note addressed to Capt. D. H. Snyder, we learn that a party of five white men made an attack on an Indian rancheria, a short distance above Big Bend, on Mad river, Saturday the 2d instant. Ten bucks were killed, and the men pushing on to close quarters the Indians placed the squaws in front as a breastwork, when two of the squaws were killed. These Indians have been hostile to the whites since the first settlement of the country, having destroyed large amounts of property belonging to the settlers, and killed white men whenever an opportunity has presented for them to do so without placing themselves in danger.—A few lessons of this nature will teach the Indians in that neighborhood to behave themselves.—*Northern Californian.*
