

INDIAN WAR CLAIMS.—For the benefit of
such of our subscribers as rendered services
or furnished supplies in this county and
Klamath in the Indian difficulties of 1855,
we publish the following notice from the
Board of Examiners created under the act of
the last session.

OFFICE BOARD EXAMINERS WAR CLAIMS,
June 9th 1857.

Sir:—The Board of Examiners created for
the purpose of examining and auditing claims
for expenses incurred in the suppression of
Indian hostilities in certain counties of this
State by act of April 25th, 1854, are now
organized, and ready to perform the duties
assigned them by said act.

The sum of \$110,000,000 has been appro-
priated for services rendered and supplies
furnished in an expedition against the Indians
in the counties of Humboldt and Klamath
in the year 1855.

Parties having claims for such pay by for-
warding the same, with the proper vouchers
to the President of said Board at Sacramen-
to, will be notified of the action thereon.
