

GONE.—A party of six men left town yesterday afternoon to carry the wounded man, Ross, to Pardee's ranch. They were composed entire of citizens of this town. There were but few packers in town when the news of the shooting of Ross, by Indians reached us, and those who were here, with the exception of Gus. Gould, manifested a perfect indifference in the matter. There is a move on foot, when the proper time arrives, for an expedition against the Upper Mad River, and Red Wood Indians, and it is to be hoped that those who are posted in the matter will not become impatient. It is bad policy to go on an excursion immediately after a depredation as the Indians will be on the look out.
