Amendatory of an Act entitled "An Act for the Government and protection of Indians," passed April twenty-second, one thousand eight handred and fifty.

Approved April 18, 1860.

The People of the State of California, represented in Senate and Assembly; do enact as

SEO. 1. Section third of said act, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: SEC. 8: County and District Judges in the respective counties of this State shall by virtue of this act, have full power and authority, at the instance and request of any person having or hereaf-ter obtaining any ladian child or children, male or female-under the age of fifteen years, from the parents or person, or persons having the scare or charge of such abild-or-childers, with the consent of such parents or person or pessons having the care or charge of any such child or children, or at the instance and request of any person desirous of obtaining any Indian or Indiana, whether children or grown persons, that may be held as prisoners of war, at the instance and request of any person destrous of obtaining any vagrant Indian or Indians, book and laye not placed themselver under the projection of any white person; to bind sad put out such indiana as apprentices, to trades, hus-bandry, of other employments as shall by them appear proper, and for this purpose shall execute duplicate articles of indenture of apprenticeally on behalf of such indians, which indentures shall also be executed by the person to whom such Indian or Indians are to be indentured; one copy of which shall be filed by the County Judge, in the Recorder scottice of the county and one copy retailed by the person to whom such Indian or Indian thorize such person to have the care, custody, con-trol and cardings, of such Indian or Indians, and shall require such person so clothe and suitably provide the necessaries of the for such Indian or Indians, for and during the term for which such Indian of Indians shall be apprenticed, and shall contain the sex, name; and probable age, of such Indian of Indians; such indentifies may be for the following terms of years to Such children as are under fourteen years of ago, if males, until they attain the age of twenty-five years, if females, until they attain the age of twenty one years; such as are over [mreen and under twenty vegra of age, if males, until they attain the age of helrty years; if females, until they attain the age of twenty-five. years and such indiana at may be over the of twenty years for and during the extron he was the west following the distribution of his skill ture at the decretion of solly's taste.
