

**TWO INDIANS KILLED.**—The Plumas Standard has an account of the killing of two Pitt River Indians, brothers of the chief Shavehead, who lately straggled into a camp of Big Meadow Indians. The latter are friendly with the whites, and took the two stragglers prisoners. A party of whites and Indians deliberated all night what to do with them, and finally determined to shoot them. When informed of their doom they did not seem to be much affected; but determined to make a bold resistance, Jim, the more desperate one of the two, caught up a gun of Hick-Bar Bill, and as quick as thought, discharged it at random among the crowd, though without doing any injury, and then commenced a flight although surrounded by a strong guard. He had scarcely gone twenty steps when twenty rifles were discharged, accompanied by the war-whoop. Three large balls taking effect in the back, he leaped into the air and fell with yells of agony, rolling on the ground. His executioners, so infuriated at his attempt to shoot some of them, rushed upon him, and ere a hand could be stayed riddled his brain. Instantaneously with the enacting of this, George, the other chief, attempted to make his escape, but was caught by one Indian Bob, and so determined was his resistance, that Bob, a perfect Hercules, was compelled to strangle him to death before releasing him.
