

TREATY WITH THE INDIANS.—On Thursday the Chiefs of five different tribes had a conference with Dr. Wozencraft, the Indian Commissioner, at the military encampment on the American river. After some "talk," it was agreed upon that the Chiefs of all the Indian tribes should assemble in general council at Weimar's Ranch, fifty miles north of this city on the Yuba river, at which time and place a treaty will undoubtedly be concluded.
