

Census.—In our issue of last week, we remarked that Mr. Espie had so far omitted to enumerate the Indians in this county, &c. In a subsequent conversation with Mr. E., he informed us that he places upon the schedule all Indians he finds domesticated, and that it is his intention to report the entire number within the county so far as he can do so with accuracy. It is impracticable for him to take the census of all the wild Indians throughout the county, formally and in strict accordance with the instructions furnished for his guidance, but it is desirable to have as near a correct return of their numbers as may be.
