

INDIAN TROUBLES IN TEHAMA COUNTY.—The Red Bluff *Beacon*, of the 3d inst., has received intelligence from Breckinridge's party, to the effect that they met a party of five Indians and one white man between the head waters of Butte and Deer Creeks. A running fight ensued, and the five Indians and white man were killed. The next day the rangers discovered a large rancheria of Indians, and succeeded in killing ten of their number, including one squaw. The party of Breckinridge are still in the mountains, and at last accounts were preparing to attack a much larger rancheria, near the head of Deer creek.
