

DOMESTICATED INDIANS.—Mr. Robenson of Eel river, called upon us yesterday, and showed us a petition which he was circulating, asking Capt. Lovell to take charge of the domesticated Indians, now in the neighborhood, until the Indian Agent shall have time to remove them to the reservation. In the present hostile state of the savages, when incursions are constantly being made, there is great liability that they may suffer the fate intended for hostile Indians only. These peaceful Indians should certainly be placed upon the reservation immediately, and kept there in future.
