

INDIAN MURDER IN SHASTA COUNTY. — Some weeks since the Indians shot and wounded a man at Kellogg's Diggings, Shasta county. On the 3d inst., in the vicinity of Watson Gulch, they stealthily crept to a cabin occupied by Charles Kelsey, and shot him dead. A little half-breed child which was in the cabin at the time was seized by the feet and its brains almost dashed out. Thirty men started out to chastise them the next morning, but with what success the *Shasta Courier*, from which we gather this information, had not learned.

The *Courier* is informed that quite a number of Indians, armed with rifles, have been prowling about Arbuckle and Harrison Gulch for some time, and has reason to believe that the people of Hay Fork, in this county, are in danger, and warns them to be on their guard.
