

STILL MORE MURDERS BY INDIANS.—It is our sad duty to chronicle again the loss of one of our best citizens. On Sunday last, O. W. Wise, of Mattolo had just completed the process of milking, and was carrying his milk towards the house, when about half way between the corral and the house he was fired upon by a party of Indians. One rifle ball and half a dozen arrows took effect, wounding him mortally. He died the next day. (Wisconsin papers please copy.)

Also on Trinity Flat, a miner was at work, when a band of Indians who appeared to be peaceable were allowed to approach. Having got within reach of their unsuspecting victim, they fell upon him, and murdered him with his own tools. From the number of tracks, there must have been about 14 Indians in this band. We have not been able to learn the name of the deceased.
