Round Valley and vicinity are committing depredations, says the Red Bluff Beacon, beyond all precedent. Seven horses were found dead at Eden Valley, one morning last week, which had been shot with poisoned arrows by the Indians. This occurred near the ranch of Wm. Robinson. Companies of volunteers are mustering and being armed and equipped, by orders of General Kibbe, to scour the adjacent country and chastise the savages. Captain Lacock (buckskin), a man of daring and much experience, has the command of the Nome Cult Rangers.
