We knew that he was of the Yuba tribe, who lived here before the settlement of Marysville, and until a few months ago when they were removed to the Nômé Lackee Reservation. We know he was here on his old familiar ground, by permission only—by leave of the Agent. We could easily, therefore, guess his thoughts. Each tree and mound was as an old friend to his eye. Here the untamed feet of his Digger boyhood played. Here he dug his worms, and caught his grasshoppers, for many, many a year that has fled.—Under those trees standing near him, many a night he made his simple couch, and slept as soundly, in his uncovered nakedness, as a king upon his costliest bed of down. Here in the midst of these scenes he lived (and loved, perhaps,) in his own rude, very rude, and simple way. We fancied we could see his heart (like a grown up child's as it was) swell within his bosom, as he remembered that his "permit," his "paper,"—must soon run out, and he return to the Reservation. We felt sorry for the poor Digger. We realized there was poetry in the life of even the humblest human being, and that even the poor despised Root Digger had a soul as well as we.—Marysville Express.~~
