~~STILL ANOTHER.~~—Two or three days since the above occurred, a party of Indians set fire to, and totally destroyed the entire grain crop of Mr. Gould who resides on Eagle Prairie, about six miles distant from Hydesville. We understand the quantity of grain destroyed was not far from one thousand bushels. This is a severe loss and will be keenly felt by Mr. Gould.
