On Monday, the 17th inst., Major Heintzleman succeeded in getting into council the Headmen of the Klamathis, with the Copas, Hanags, Yau-tuck-ets and Tolawas, which he had recently removed on to the Reservation, at which time a treaty was made, in which they agreed to bury all animosities that have heretofore existed between them—to live together in peace and submit any difficulties that may arise between them to the officer in charge of the Reserve for settlement.
