

**INDIANS SENT TO THE RESERVATION.—**  
We are informed that the people of Mattole Valley have sent quite a large number of Indians to the Mendocino Reservation, under a guard of citizens. This was done without knowing if they would be received by the Agent in charge, but the citizens of the valley are resolved that they will not longer tolerate the presence of Indians in their midst. This plan should be adopted throughout the county. The Indians are the wards of the Government, and for their protection and subsistence the reservations were established and are maintained at a great expense. There the Indians can have a home. Running at large they are a dangerous nuisance—a blighting curse to the country. If the agents have not the means or disposition to remove them, let the people take it in hand, and there is no danger but that the agents will devise some means to subsist all the Indians sent to them.
