

KILLED BY INDIANS:—John D. Sluicer, of the North Fork of Cow Creek, Shasta, was killed by the Indians week before last. Some articles having been stolen from his horse, which he knew had been taken by neighboring Indians, he proceeded to their camp, and demanded their restoration. The Indians refused to give them up, and Sluicer snapped his gun at one of them. The gun missed fire, and two of the Indians commenced shooting their arrows at him, while several others commenced making hostile demonstrations. Three arrows struck him in the body, and he died of the wounds.
