Kibbe, who was here during the past week investigating Indian troubles in this and Humboldt counties, is advised that the Assistant Adjutant General addressed a note to Gov. Weller with information that all spare troops had been sent to Fort Humboldt, which must suffice for protection until a larger force, shortly to be placed at Gen. Clarke's disposal, enables him to obtain full control over the Indians.
