Pursuant to instructions received from the Department of Interior, dated Washington City, July 28th, 1864, relative to the "former indebtedness of the Government on account of the Indian service in California," I hereby give notice to all persons having claims against the Government for supplies furnished or services rendered the Indian Department of this State under the Superintendence of Hanson, Steele and Wentworth, to present the same to me at my office, southeast corner of Washington and Sansome streets, San Francisco, on or before the first day of December, 1864, so that they may be forwarded to Washington for final settlement. Affidavits from responsible parties will be required to establish the correctness and justice of said accounts.
