> THE INDIANS IN BUTE COUNTY.—The Marysville Appeal says: We learn from Superintendent Hanson that about 600 Indians have been collected at Pence's ranch, Butte county, under the recent order of the citizens' meeting. Of these about 50 are sick, sone nigh- unto death, with a kind of billouis intermittent fever. Thirty of the poor oreatures have died within the last three weeks. Mr. Hanson intends to be gin the work of removing them to Round Valley early the coming week. It would be better, he thinks, tortals them up the coast, but the cost would be appropriation for the ordinary expanse of hisdistrict.
