

LATER.

Owen Washington has died from his wounds to-day. A man by the name of Martin was killed on Big Flat, Trinity River, to-day. The Indians are still coming up the river, and are now within twenty miles of this place, and every one is anxiously waiting a reply from the Governor for aid.

We have every reason to believe that these men have been murdered, but we have some hopes that things are not quite as bad as reported. The Indians have been growing bitter against the whites along the lower Trinity the past year, and since the murder of Madame Weaver and Merritt, two months since, no white people have lived on Trinity, between Cedar Flat and Hoopa. We wait anxiously for further news from that quarter, and will probably receive it to-day.
