

REMODELING OF OUR INDIAN SYSTEM.

Dr. Elijah White, who has been a resident on this coast for twenty-five years, has been appointed by the Government special Indian Agent for California, Oregon, and Washington Territory. Dr. White is thoroughly conversant with Indian affairs, having been the accredited agent of the Government for several years before the treaty of London. He will first proceed to the Humboldt region, and endeavor to settle the difficulties which have recently taken place there. We are assured by him that Mr. Lincoln's Administration has determined to make some radical changes in the system which has heretofore been pursued in relation to the Indians, and that some attempt will be made to civilize them. Humanity loudly demands that some change shall be made.—*Alla.*
