

Laid Over.—Mr. Loop, the mail carrier between Union and Weaverville, laid over this week, being unable to get any one to escort him through the hostile Indian portion of his route. Hereafter, Capt. Underwood, who has taken the field, will keep the route open for the regular transportation of the mail.
