

INDIANS CAPTURED.—We are informed that Company E, Captain Simpson, 1st Bat. Mts. stationed at camp Grant has captured within the last two months, some two hundred of the upper Eel River Indians and taken them to the Round Valley Reservation. These Indians have been, it is said for a long time past committing depredations upon the stock ranging over that portion of Mendocino county, and the southern and eastern part of this county. Capt. Simpson, his officers and men have displayed great energy in hunting, fighting and capturing Indians, and are entitled to much credit for the services they have thus rendered to this and Mendocino counties.
